# Do you offer scholarships?

We offer generous scholarships of up to £2,500\* per year to help with the cost of study.

# How long will I study for?

Bachelors 3 years • Masters 1 year-18 months Integrated Undergraduate Masters 4 years.

### Where is the University of South Wales?

South Wales, UK with campuses in Cardiff, Newport and Pontypridd. Wales is a country in its own right, but is part of the UK. We have an international airport in Cardiff, but can also be reached from London in around 2 and a half hours. South Wales is a friendly, safe and inexpensive place to live.

#### When do courses start?

September (undergraduate and postgraduate) and February (mainly postgraduate).

# **Entry requirements?**

For undergraduate entry:

- Applicants with the Sijil Tinggi Pelajaran Malaysia (STPM), Unified Examination
  Certificate (UEC), the Matriculation Certificate of the Senior Secondary Assessment
  Board of South Australia, and the Canadian High School or Secondary School
  Diplomas, International Baccalaureate Diploma with higher grades of between 655445 (equivalent to 112-80 UCAS tariff), or 'A'levels obtained in Malaysia will all be
  considered for direct entry onto a Bachelor degree.
- Certificate and Diploma holders from Polytechnics, Institutes of Technology, and private colleges will also be considered for direct entry to Bachelor degree courses. We are happy to consider for students for advanced entry where possible.

For postgraduate entry: Applicants with a good Bachelor degree from a UK recognised university will be considered for postgraduate Masters degree courses.

# What about English?

For undergraduate courses: IELTS 6.0, IGCSE English Language C.

For most postgraduate courses: IELTS 6.0, IGCSE English Language C.

# How much money will I spend?

We estimate that between £145 and £166 should cover your weekly living costs (including accommodation).





# What scholarships are available?
