### **School Overview**

Leeds Beckett University is a modern professional university with ambition. They are located in the vibrant city of Leeds, which has the largest financial district outside of London. ## Scholarships and Bursaries\*



#### **International Student Scholarship**

Leeds Beckett values the diversity that international students bring to campus and are delighted to offer the following scholarships to all eligible students:

**International Foundation Year** - £1,500

Undergraduate Courses - £1,000 per year

Postgraduate Courses - £3,000

Research Courses - £1,500

To be eligible for the scholarship discount students must:

- Be assessed as having an 'Overseas/Non-EU' residency status
- Be assessed to pay the overseas fee, studying the relevant course full time, and actively enrolled on an eligible course
- Be a self-funded student who is paying the full course fee for that year (those students who have their tuition fees paid by a third-party sponsor, employer or government agency will not be eligible)
- Studying that level of the course for the first time (i.e. not repeating any level during that year)
