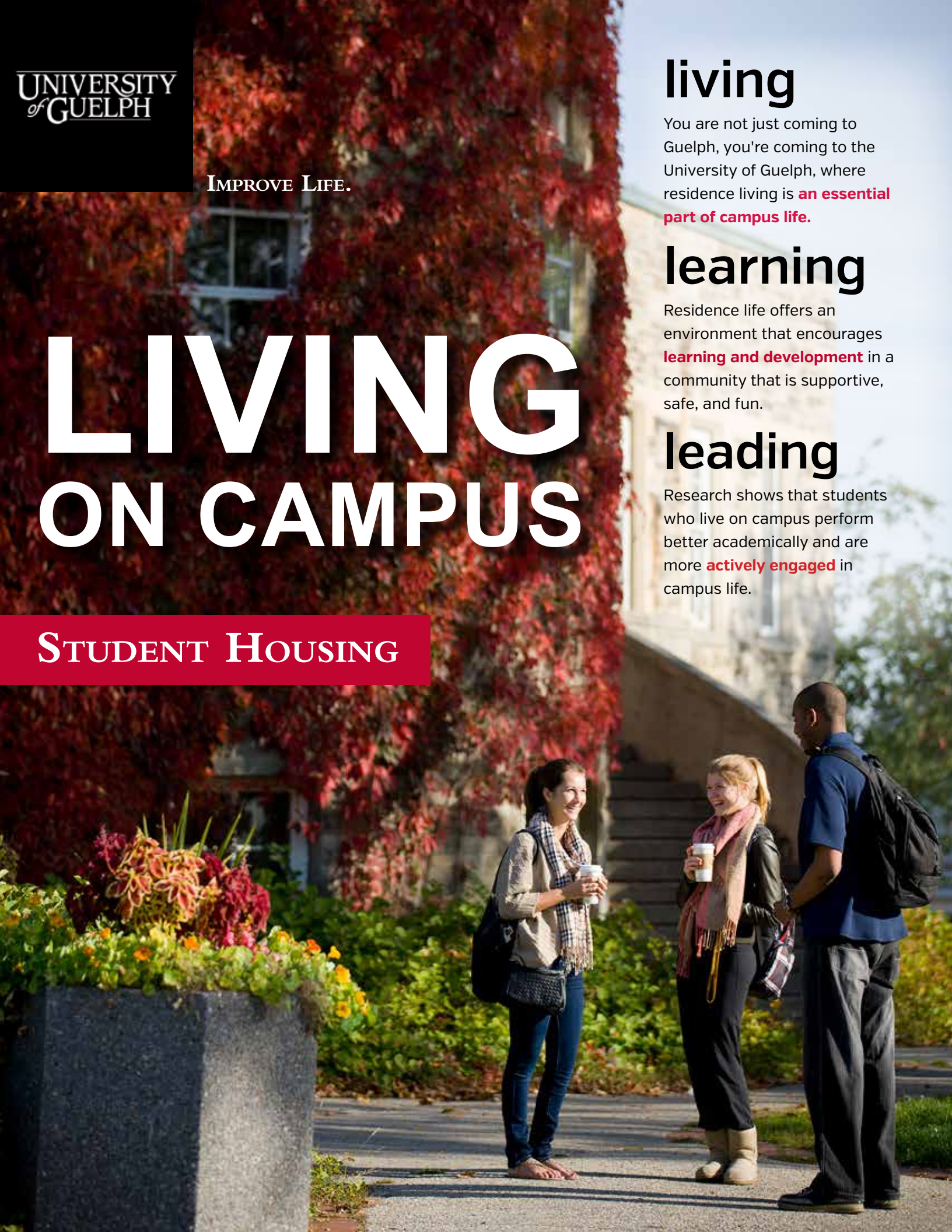

All new semester-one students entering a full-time undergraduate degree program are guaranteed residence, provided that you complete your online Residence Application **and** submit a \$750 residence deposit by

Monday, June 1, 2020



How to **APPLY ONLINE**

It's easy! Step-by-step instructions can be found in your Offer of Admission package or on our website. The Residence Application is completed online.

START by going to our website at housing.uoguelph.ca.

READ our **Viewbook** to help you select the best residence options for you.

LOG IN to our Housing Portal and select the Residence Application from the top menu. All new semester-one students should select the F20/W21 application.

FOLLOW the on-screen instructions that will guide you through the Application.

CHOOSE a Residence Learning Community if you are interested in this option.

SUBMIT the application when prompted to do so. You will receive a confirmation email if submitted successfully.

PAY your \$750 Residence Deposit using online banking by the June 1st deadline.

NOTE: Your Application is not complete until the Residence Deposit is received.

RESIDENCE LEARNING COMMUNITIES bring together groups of 15 to 50 students with common social and academic interests. You may choose to apply to several Residence Learning Communities, including Living Learning Centres (LLC), Themed Learning Communities (TLC) and Academic Learning Clusters (ALC).

Students from all degree programs are welcome to apply to our Residence Learning Communities. To apply, please select LLC, TLC or ALC on your residence application. Students who apply to an ALC will be assigned together in Academic Clusters with other students in the same program.

Located in East Residence, students who request an alcohol-free living environment will be assigned with suitemates who have also indicated this preference.

DESK SERVICES

We operate a 24 hour Service Desk in the North and South residence areas, and an East Service Desk open until midnight, seven days a week.

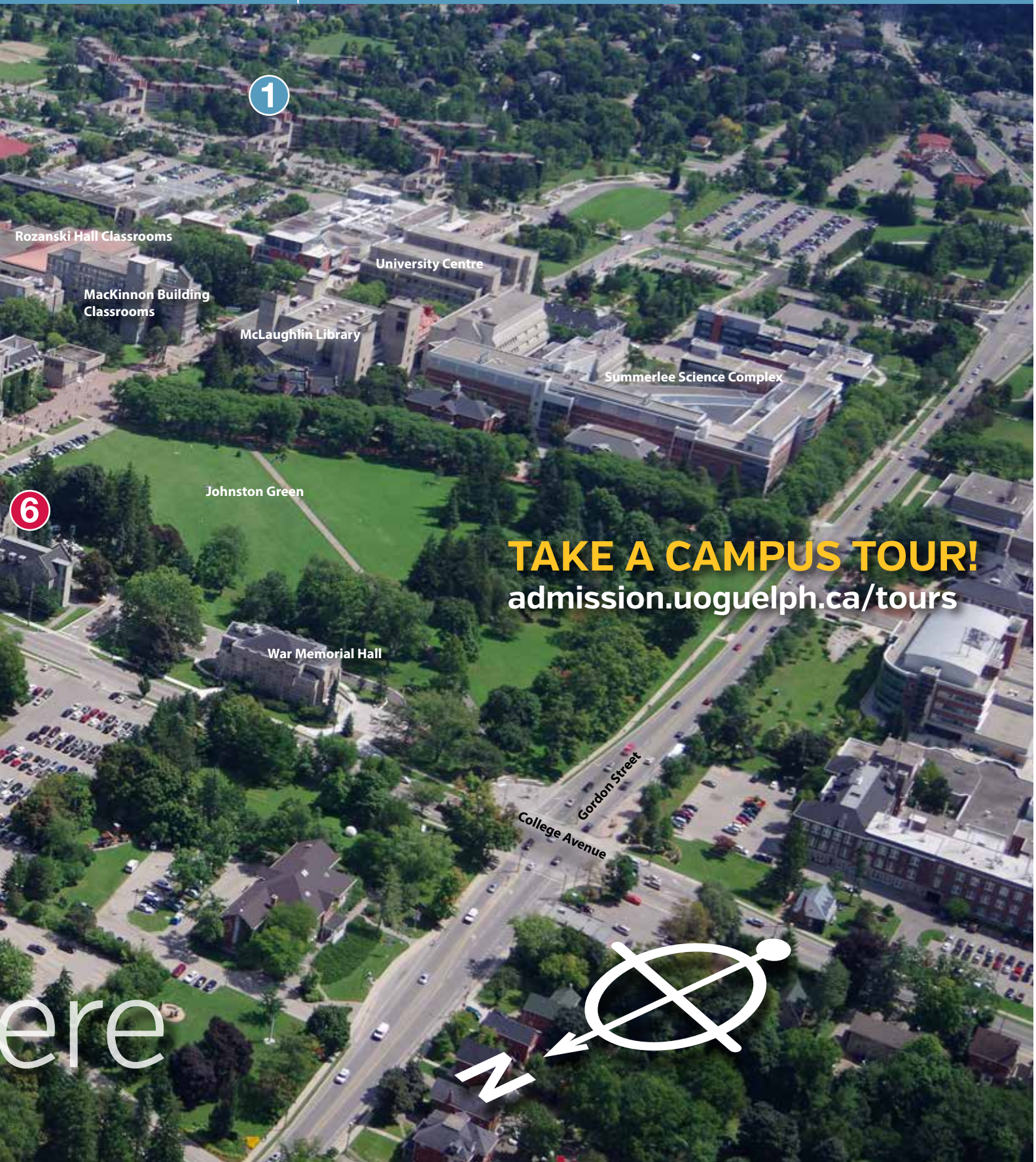
