To be eligible for the Global Study Awards applicants must:

- Be 18-years-old or over;
- Have taken an IELTS test at a British Council centre and received an official Test Report Form issued by the British Council;
- Have a valid International Student Identity Card (ISIC) or International Youth Travel Card (IYTC);
- Enroll on a full-time undergraduate or postgraduate programme abroad;
- Provide an acceptance letter from the relevant institution
