Global MBA International Scholarship Fund

The Leicester Castle Business School offers four Global MBA International Scholarships of **£2,500**. The amount is applied as a course fee reduction for those paying international student fees in 2020/2021. These are available to international students who have excelled academically and have an offer of admission for the full-time Global MBA program. Award students scholarship is through an application and selection process, where students will need to provide a statement of no more than 1000 words, demonstrating their commitment to DMU values.
