Baldwin Honors Program

Annual Scholarships Up to \$27,500

If you are invited into the Baldwin Honors Program, you could receive a \$25,000 Francis Asbury Scholarship and a \$2,500 Baldwin Honors Scholarship toward your tuition each year.

Eligibility

To be considered for the Baldwin Honors Program, you'll have earned an A average while enrolled in your high school's most rigorous college preparatory program.

While we strongly encourage that students take the SAT/ACT and score a minimum of 1300 on the SAT or 28 on the ACT, students who are test-optional will be considered for entry.

Other Awards

You can apply for other awards and programs for honors students. The Drew Action Scholars award is for those who show extraordinary commitment to the community, or you can take a deep dive into your favorite topic through Specialized Honors.
