International Bursaries and Merit Awards

Amount: **£1,000 - £2,000** fee bursary

Eligibility

Any non-EU international undergraduate student in any subject.

As an International student, you are eligible for £1,000 - £2,000 towards your course fees for the first year of study. We assess eligibility and funding amounts on a case by case basis. This depends on your course, application and country.

How to Apply

You should apply for your chosen course through the normal application process. After you receive an offer, fill out the scholarship application form. If you're successful, you'll be notified by email and we'll deduct the award amount from the second installment of your tuition fees.
