School Overview

The University of Reading was established in 1892 and originated as a University of Oxford extension college. Today, they are among the top 30 UK universities in world rankings and have a world-class reputation for the quality of their teaching, research, and links to business. International Foundations Program (IFP) Ambassador Scholarship

This scholarship provides IFP students with a £2,500 discount on tuition fees for the IFP year and is open for all non-sponsored international fee-paying students.

International (non-EU) fee-paying students from Japan, Korea, Vietnam, Indonesia, Africa, South Asia (India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Bhutan) Commonwealth of the Independent States and the Americas progressing from the Foundation Certificate will receive £1,000 off tuition fees for Year 1 of their (non-clinical) degree at the University of Liverpool.
